This Tuesday March 2nd marks the hundredth day of captivity for Olivier D. and Olivier F., two members of the team of *Triangle G H* kidnapped last November 22nd in Birao in Central African Republic. The Association is more than ever mobilized to obtain their liberation as soon as possible. It fully joins their families, friends and work colleagues in this painful event they are going through, all together deeply concerned and in the expectation of their quick return.

Operating in Central African Republic since 2007, the association implements different programmes towards the populations living in the High Kotto and in the Vakaga Regions (North of the country), in the fields of education, water access and food security. It also brings its support to the refugee populations originating from Darfur (Sudan).

The association Triangle G H was created in 1994 and is currently working in about ten countries in Africa and in Asia. Its interventions are characterized by an integrated approach in the fields of water hygiene and sanitation, food security and rural development, socio educative and psychosocial.
